The universal underframe is supplied with the kit and depending on your signage you can shave/cut off the handwheel or the lever brake from the underframe CAREFULLY if you want to.

- 1) Test fit the 2.5 mm 3ply inner base to the wagon and once happy use MDF PVA to adhere it
- 2) Underframe insert old Micro-Trains pizza-cutter wheels into each axle, starting with the side that does **NOT** have the 'V'-grooved axle box, then insert the opposite side. To remove, simply reverse the process. For better underframe paint coverage while still protecting the pinpoint bearing faces, it's recommended to clip the flanges off the wheels
- 3) Spray both the wagon and underframe the same colour and once dry trim the signage as close as possible to the printed outline on the photographic print using **ONLY SHARP** new blades in your hobby knife or micro scissors with sharp blades
- 4) Test fit against the wagon side and adjust accordingly and once happy paint MDF PVA onto the U van side and adhere the signage. White edges can be masked by using Watercolour pencils along the edges before gluing
- 5) Fit Microtrains 1015 couplers with the supplied screws
- 6) Trial fit the underframe over the couplers, you may have to file the area around the coupler to achieve this and when happy use PVA/MDF and glue it in place. DO NOT FORCE the underframe as it is not that flexible being resin
